Dear Global Shortwave Club member:

It is crucial to ensure you have access to the news during emergencies. If the power is out, eventually, the batteries will run down, leaving you without vital information. However, some radios have alternative means of charging that might interest you. You can buy these radios from Amazon.



The first is the Raynic Emergency Radio, a 12000mAh/44400mWh Battery-Operated Weather Radio. It features six charging methods: an AC Adapter, a rechargeable battery inside, solar power, three AAA batteries (not included), type-C Charging, and crank hand power. The price is only \$42.99.

The second is the 12000 Emergency Radio, a NOAA Weather Radio with AM/FM/NOAA/SW; it includes Battery-Operated SOS. It features six charging methods: three AAA batteries (not included), a type-C input, a built-in lithium-ion battery, a hand crank, and a solar panel. The price is only \$42.99.





The third is the Raynic Emergency Radio, a 5000mAh/18500mWh Weather Radio. It features six charging methods: an AC Adapter, a rechargeable battery inside, solar power, three AAA batteries (not included), USB Charging, and crank hand power. The price is only \$35.99. (My personal recommendation.)
